


# Trinity Ohana Expectations

As a family, our kuleana (responsibility) to one another is to be committed to the safety guidelines and policies listed to protect our students, staff, and faculty. By enrolling your child at Trinity, please follow these guidelines:

- Follow Federal, State and Local Orders for COVID-19.
- Stay at home if sick.
- Stay home if exposed to a person who has tested positive to COVID-19 or has experienced possible exposure.
- Notify school if child or household member tests positive.
- Temperature check child at home before school, as any child with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will be sent home.
- Face Masks - Child must have face mask when exiting car until in the classroom. Wearing a mask in the classroom is optional. Teach and practice how to properly use and remove a face mask. If using fabric masks, please wash your child's mask regularly. Due to the number of students in the classroom, 3rd, 4th and 6th grade will be provided face shields for students and teachers, if requested.



# Trinity Ohana Expectations Continued

- Hygiene - Please teach, practice and enforce good hygiene practices at home, such as proper and frequent handwashing.
  - Student Personal Items - Limit the items your child brings onto campus each day and explain to your child about not sharing food, supplies and other items with their classmates.
  - Medical Forms, Emergency Contacts - Parents must complete, submit and/or update all required medical forms prior to the first day of school. Please provide three emergency contacts in the event that your child is ill and needs to be taken home.

# Classroom

- Face coverings optional for both students and teacher
- Wash hands throughout the day
- Student desks will be at least 3 ft apart when possible
- School meals will be individually plated or served following distancing precautions
- Personal items will not be shared
- Excursions will be postponed until the Spring
- Camps/Overnight trips remain scheduled and are dependent upon the location



# Campus Safety

- ① Hand Hygiene: Have soap and water and/or hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol available in work and public settings for use by employees, students and the public
- ① Monitor Health: Screen staff, faculty, students and visitors for overt signs of illness in a safe and respectful manner
- ① Plexiglass barriers and partitions in front office
- ① Signs posting:
  - protective measures (prevent spreading by sneezing or coughing in elbow or armpit)
  - proper handwashing
  - physical distancing
  - staying home when sick

# Campus Safety continued

- ① Visitors: Preapproved visitors will be screened upon arrival
- ① Regular cleanings of high-touch areas (door handles, sink handles and stair rails)
- ① Designated areas for sick children to be picked up



# School Day

- Class schedules remain the same

- Physical Education - PE classes will be scheduled while maintaining safe conditions. Makai Swim will be provided dependent upon the availability of the pool. Recess will continue to be supervised with modified guidelines.
