Please note the school's philosophy of pricing which includes all common fees and expenses in the annual tuition amount. The 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Big Island Trip, 6<sup>th</sup> Grade USS Missouri Overnight, 7-12 Grade Lions' Camp, 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Grand Tour in Europe, and over 55 other field trips, which are subject to change, are included in the cost of tuition for full time students.
