Our two campuses are located at two convenient spots in Kailua, Hawaii, which is easily accessible from Kaneohe, Honolulu, Waimanalo, and Aiea. Preschool-3rd Grade is taught on our Mauka Campus at 875 Auloa Road, while 4th-12th Grade is taught our Makai Campus at 1110 Kailua Road.

All summer classes are held on the Mauka Campus.

Trinity Christian School's (TCS) Summer Advantage program is designed to provide students K– 6th Grade with an opportunity to review and enrich their knowledge in an environment that stimulates creativity and a love for learning.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

Students entering Kindergarten to 6th grade in Fall 2022 are eligible to apply for Summer Advantage. Kindergarten students must be born on or before June 30, 2017.

REGISTRATION

March 1-May 15 Registration

Our online registration/payment form is accessible using the registration form link in the March 1 Summer Advantage email, the Tabula newsletter, and on the school's website. The online form will require the full payment at the time of submission via credit card or ACH bank withdrawal. A NSF Fee of \$30 will be assessed on returned payments. Program cost includes \$100 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit.

Summer Advantage programs have a maximum enrollment and classes are filled in the order registration forms are received. Early registration is highly recommended since most classes reach maximum enrollment. All classes are held on our Mauka Campus, located at 875 Auloa Road.

<u>March 1</u> — Priority Registration for currently enrolled TCS students who are also enrolled for next school year.

April 1 — Registration opens for community enrollment.

LATE REGISTRATION

May 16 to May 30 Late Registration

If space is available, registration will be assessed a Late Fee of \$50. The link mentioned above will no longer be accessible. The Late Registration Form will be available through the school website. No late registrations will be accepted after May 30, Memorial Day.

CONFIRMATION OF REGISTRATION

A confirmation of registration email will be sent within 2 weeks to the email address on record. If no email address is provided, registration cannot be confirmed. Confirmation will not be mailed to the home address.

WITHDRAWALS/ REFUNDS/ CHANGES

If a student is withdrawn from Summer Advantage, the \$100 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit will not be refunded. After May 15, no tuition refunds will be given.

Notification of class withdrawal or program changes needs to be submitted with the **Summer Program Change Form** only, which can be found on our website through this LINK.

One program change will be accepted at no cost; subsequent changes will result in a \$50 change fee. Requests for changes will not be accepted over the phone or email. Refunds, minus the \$100 deposit, will be made by a reimbursement check.

Trinity Christian School reserves the right to cancel any class if there is insufficient enrollment.

KINDERGARTEN

KINDERGARTEN READINESS

Our program is designed to enhance your student's readiness for kindergarten by focusing on reviewing and strengthening previously learned skills while promoting social adjustment in the classroom. Developmentally appropriate curriculum will be creatively introduced through language arts, math, social studies, science, and Bible.

* PLEASE NOTE

Kindergarten students must be born on or before 6/30/2017. For newly enrolling students, immunization/health record and a copy of the student's birth certificate must be submitted to the TCS Admissions staff no later than 1 week prior to start of student's Summer session. Your student will not be allowed to attend without this documentation on file, per Hawaii State regulations.



1st GRADE, 2nd—3rd GRADE, 4th—6th GRADE

Don't get caught in the "summer slide!" By continuing to review facts and staying engaged in learning, your student can maintain and even increase the skills and knowledge they acquired during the school year and will be ready to leap forward in August. During the Summer Advantage programs, students will be covering grade appropriate language arts and math. They will also have music instruction each day as well as "Game Time" and time for free play and recess. The students will be separated into grade-specific cohorts throughout the morning program—one for first grade, one for second to third grade; and one for fourth to sixth grade.

Afternoon Discovery

Students will enjoy a variety of afternoon activities, both indoors and out, including swimming. This program is only available to students who attend the morning session.
