## GENERAL INFORMATION

### MISSION

We believe students should be actively engaged and find joy in the process of learning. Trinity Christian School's Summer Advantage program is designed to provide students in Preschool through 6th Grade with an opportunity to review and enrich their knowledge in an environment that stimulates creativity and a love of learning.

### ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

Students entering Pre-Kingergarten to 6th grade in Fall 2026 are eligible to apply for the Summer Advantage program.

**Rising 7th through 9th grade students may apply for Musical Theatre.** Preschool students must be enrolled at Trinity for the 25-26 or 26-27 school year. Rising Kindergarten students must be five on or before June 30, 2026.

Applicants with no prior TCS experience must provide the student's immunization and health records (forms are available in our office) and original birth certificate (we will copy and return to you). These forms should be turned into the TCS Office at 875 Auloa Road with the Registration Form and payment. Your student will not be allowed to attend the Summer Advantage Program without this documentation on file per Hawaii State regulations.

### REGISTRATION

**March 1** - Priority Registration for TCS students who are enrolled for the 26-27 school year

**March 15** - Registration opens for community enrollment for Rising Kindergarten through 6th Grade students. Rising 7th through 9th grade students may apply for Musical Theatre.

**April 15** - Last day to withdraw

**May 15** - Registration closes

**Payment is due at time of registration.** TCS Students will be billed via FACTS within one week of receipt of application. Non-TCS students must submit the payment form with application. Pending availability, late registration will be assessed a Late Fee of \$100.

Summer Advantage Programs have a maximum enrollment and classes are filled in the order registration forms are received. Early registration is highly recommended since most classes reach maximum enrollment. **All classes are held on our Mauka Campus, located at 875 Auloa Road.**
