### **Admissions Requirements**

Students entering 1 to 6th grade in 2025 are eligible to apply for Summer Advantage. See 3s and 4s page as well as Preschool 5s page for age requirements.

# Registration

Trinity students who are returning to TCS in the fall are given priority registration until March 31. On April 1st, registration will open to the general public for rising 5s to sixth grade on a first-come, first-served basis. Preschool 3s and 4s are only open to TCS students from 2024-2025 or 2025-2026.

All classes are held on our Mauka Campus, located at 875 Auloa Road. Summer School workshops have a maximum enrollment. Early registration is highly recommended since most classes reach maximum enrollment. For all families, registration and payment is online. Registration is not complete until payment is made. PKS and Staff children need to email Erin Lin for registration.

# **Registration and Tuition Deadlines**

<u>March 1, 2025</u>—Registration opens for returning and incoming TCS students. Payment due at registration. If you withdraw before May 15, 2025, payment minus \$100 service fee will be returned.

<u>April 1, 2025</u>—Registration opens to the general public. Payment due at registration. If you withdraw before May 15, 2025, payment minus \$100 service fee will be returned.

May 15, 2025—Last day for refunds on tuition.

<u>May 15 to Memorial Day 2025</u> —Late Registration (if space is available) will be assessed a Late Fee of \$50. No registration will be accepted after Memorial Day for Session 1.

June 15, 2025—Second session late registration ends.

# **Confirmation of Registration**

A confirmation of registration email will be sent to the email address on record. If no email address is provided, registration cannot be confirmed. Confirmation will not be mailed to the home address. If we are unable to register a student in the requested class due to class size limitation, the student will be enrolled in the other grade level course, if offered, and you will be notified of the change by email.

# Withdrawal / Refunds / Changes

No tuition refunds will be given after May 15, 2025. Notification of withdrawal or program changes needs to be submitted with the Summer Program Change Form only. One program change will be accepted at no cost; subsequent changes will result in a \$25 change fee. Requests for changes will not be accepted over the phone or email.

# **Cancellation of Classes**

Trinity Christian School reserves the right to cancel or change any class if there is insufficient enrollment or the lack of a teacher. In the event of a class cancellation or change by the school, the student will be enrolled in the other grade level course, if offered, and you will be notified of the class change. If this class is not acceptable to you, notify the school immediately and the deposit and tuition will be refunded.

# Session 1: June 2 – June 27 (No class June 11)

#### Readiness for 3s ~ 8:00am -2:30pm

Our program is designed to enhance your student's readiness for PK by focusing on fine and gross motor skills while promoting social adjustment in the classroom. Bible and thematic units will be creatively taught using developmentally appropriate curriculum. Half the morning is spent outside facilitating gross motor development and learning socialization skills, while the other half is inside working on circle time activities facilitating fine motor skills. Swimming is taught each day, and lunch and snacks are included.

#### Readiness for 4s ~ 8:00am -2:30pm

Our program is designed to enhance your student's readiness for JK by focusing on fine and gross motor skills while promoting social adjustment in the classroom. Bible and thematic units will be creatively taught using developmentally appropriate curriculum. Half the morning is spent outside facilitating gross motor development and learning socialization skills, while the other half is inside working on numbers and phonics while facilitating fine motor skills. Swimming is taught each day, and lunch and snacks are included.
